Ornamental Grasses

Ornamental grasses offer a great diversity of form, texture, color, height and growing preferences. They can be used as a specimen piece or in groupings. Most of these grasses prefer a sunny locations, but there are some that do best with shady areas. Most ornamental grasses are pest-free and other than a yearly pruning in mid-March, require very little maintenance.

Ornamental Grasses can...

- enhance the formality of a public garden
- add depth to natural settings
- provide areas for wildlife to hide and nest
- create a screen for hiding unsightly areas or for privacy
- act as groundcover and erosion control
- give accent and height to annual containers

FAQ: Do I need to cut my grass back before winter?

A: Grasses do not need to be cut down before winter. In fact they are attractive when left standing and the foliage helps to insulate the crown. Cut back the foliage to about 4-6" in the spring before growth resumes.
